NEW BUSINESS

NUISANCE ORDINANCE – AMENDMENTS

In response to Josele Cleary's questions in her January 11, 2017 correspondence Council decided to make the following changes:

Chapter 5-204 – Minimum penalty for violation of Article 2, Abandoned Articles, of Chapter 5, Health and Sanitation, increase to \$100.00.

Article 4 – Grass, weeds and other vegetation set minimum penalty of \$100.00.

Section 5-302- Household pets, It was decided to eliminate Farm Pigs and Rats from the Ordinance.

Section 5-304.B – Setbacks for small animals – Council decided to make the back corner of yard as the setback.

Gerald Boughter made the motion, seconded by Dick Charles to make the changes. Motion passed.
